Spring Valley NewsLeaf Update for November/December 2024 – January 2025

Spring Valley's grounds and facilities transitioned to 'winter' hours on November 1. We continue to offer a full schedule of family, youth, and adult programs and unique events.

- Spring Valley's grounds and walking trails are open for walkers every day from 8am-5pm.
- NOTE: the parking area at St. Matthew's Catholic Church will remain accessible and the gate accessing Heritage Farm will remain open into the winter months this year.
- The **Nature Center Museum** is open to visitors every day from 10am-4pm. NOTE that all facilities will be closed in Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.
- Volkening Heritage Farm's Visitor Center and other farm buildings are open Wednesday-Sunday from 10am-4pm through the end of November. After that, they will be closed during the winter months.
- **Bison's Bluff Nature Playground** is open daily from 10am-4pm, weather permitting. During the winter months, there is no admission fee to use the playground.
- The Merkle Cabin is available for small private events when not scheduled for programs. Requests for rentals need to be submitted at least two weeks in advance. Rates are based on residency.
- Volunteers continue to assist with outdoor conservation projects, trail maintenance, and with events and programs. If you are willing and able to assist with projects, please contact Spring Valley's Volunteer Coordinator, Sarah Severson at saseverson@parkfun.com.

Spring Valley App

Staff has developed a Spring Valley site use app that works with either Android or Apple smartphones. It features not only information on hours, site features, and facilities, but two guided tours that provide information on various natural history or historical topics as you walk the trails. The app is FREE and available from either the Google Play Store or Apple Store (simply type Spring Valley Nature Center into the search bar). It is also available as a web-app by going to www.springvalley.stqry.app.

Autumn and Holiday Events & Programs

NOTE: On-line pre-registration is required for most Spring Valley programs as they have limited capacity and spots often fill quickly, so early registration is advised. Most special events have walk-in admission paid when you arrive. You can always call the Nature Center during business hours, and staff will be happy to assist you with registration.

Hoghouse to Smokehouse - Sun., Nov. 10, 10:00am-2:00pm

Join us for this popular event at Heritage Farm that explores the ways in which 19th century farm families prepared meat for the winter ahead. See how bacon, hams, and sausage were made and preserved in the smokehouse for later consumption. Learn about the importance of pork to the German diet. Food and beverages will be available for purchase as well. Admission to the event is \$3/person or \$12/family, with children 2 and under admitted free.

Spring Valley Holiday Craft Fair – Sat. & Sun., Nov. 30 & Dec. 1, 10:00am-4:00pm

Plan to visit the Nature Center on Thanksgiving weekend to peruse the displays of hand-crafted gift items available from our vendors. From jewelry to unique home decorations, you'll be sure to find something for those on your holiday gift list. Spring Valley Nature Club will be selling food and beverages as well. Admission is free!

Christmas in the Valley –Sunday, Dec. 8, 12:00-4:00pm

Experience a 19th century farm Christmas at Heritage Farm with demonstrations in the farmhouse, stop by a warm fire for cocoa or soup, and walk to the Merkle Cabin for children's crafts and a visit with St. Nick. A wagon shuttle will transport you between the farm and cabin areas. Admission is \$3/person or \$12/family, with children under 3 are free.
